TB Global Technologies Ltd. (Kyobashi Edogrand 28F, Laurent Poidevin, President, hereinafter referred to as TBG) will exhibit at Food Factory 2022 to be held at Tokyo Big Sight from September 28 (Wed) to September 30 (Fri), 2022.

This is the first time for TBG to participate in this exhibition, which is a specialized trade show for equipment and devices related to facility improvement and engineering in food factories.
